SANDBURG SCHOOL PROGRAM REPORT

CHAMPION - JENNI WOLFE

The Sandburg Unicycle Club currently has 10 members, most of whom are 4th-5th graders. Jenni Wolfe, a first grade teacher and Maduni Board Member, leads the group which meets on Tuesdays from 3:30-4:30 p.m. She has placed an emphasis on recruiting female riders this year. Three returning riders from Sherman, Kylan Schnake, Owen Buske and Maelin Her, join our group to lead uni games like hockey, basketball, and Sharks and Minnows. During the spring unicycle class, we will rehearse for our annual Sandburg Unicycle Show, and begin distance training for the end of year rolling field trip to Rheindahl Park and beyond.



NUESTRO MUNDO SCHOOL PROGRAM REPORT

CHAMPION - BRIAN ANDERSON

Nuestro Mundo school unicycle club continued this year, starting up in late October with 13 riders. It was something of a comeback story, after school champion, John Wheeler (a great name for someone who promotes unicycling, btw) left Madison to go on active military duty. Jenni Wolf got the program started as an MMSD after-school program. Lauren Johnson contributes her skills as a volunteer coach and quickly developed an easy rapport with the students, who are in grades three through five.

Returning riders include Shay (I don't know his last name, but he comes to Sunday practices), who passed level two skills test and reports being almost ready for level three, Anabella Huesca Cimino and Henry Forehand (the principal's son). The slow start to the program and winter weather haven't stopped the kids. The slow, steady progress they're making is punctuated by some real breakthrough moments. MARQUETTE/O'KEEFFE SCHOOL PROGRAM REPORT CHAMPION - JILL COHAN

The Marquette/O'Keeffe Open Gym/Unicycle Club is continuing to be a gathering spot for kids to make new friends and stay connected with old friends through unicycling.

Riders assist new riders in learning whether it is with the 9-10 Marquette Unicycle Club participants or the 20 or so O'Keeffe Middle School students who drop in and try a new experience.

Once the newer riders are comfortable practicing on their own, the accomplished riders play games, practice new skills or simply socialize on one wheel.

The club has grown this year after the O'Keeffe Phy Ed department offered a unicycling/rollerblading unit! It is now typical to have 50 or more riders on any given Friday.

KEGONSA SCHOOL PROGRAM REPORT

Our newest program at Kegonsa began in November with 10 brand new riders in 1st-4th grades.. A second session of riders has started with 10 new riders and 3 returning riders from the first session who now have their own unicycles! So far, the first graders are kicking the older kids' butts!


